

PRIVACY POLICY

NPC Robotics, Corp. ("NPC," "we," "us," or "our") respects the privacy of individuals who visit our Website or communicate with us.

This Privacy Policy describes how NPC may collect, use, disclose, retain, and protect personal information when you visit npcrobotics.com (the "Website"), submit information through the Website, or otherwise interact with NPC in circumstances covered by this Policy.

1. INFORMATION WE COLLECT

Depending upon how you interact with NPC, we may collect the following categories of information.

Information You Provide

Information you voluntarily provide may include:

- › Name;
- › Business email address;
- › Telephone number;
- › Company or organization;
- › Job title;
- › Mailing or business address;
- › Information contained in messages or inquiries;
- › Requests for quotations;
- › Product or technical interests;
- › Communication preferences; and other information you choose to provide.

Information Collected Automatically

When you visit the Website, certain information may be collected automatically, including:

- › Internet Protocol ("IP") address;
- › Browser type;
- › Device type;
- › Operating system;

- › Pages viewed;
- › Referring website;
- › Date and time of access;
- › Approximate geographic information derived from IP address;
- › Website interactions; and other technical, diagnostic, and security information.

2. INFORMATION YOU SHOULD NOT SUBMIT THROUGH THE WEBSITE

NPC's public Website and general contact forms are not intended for the transmission of classified, export-controlled, or other highly sensitive technical information.

Unless NPC expressly authorizes a particular transmission method, do not submit through general Website forms or ordinary email:

- › Classified information;
- › Controlled Unclassified Information ("CUI");
- › ITAR-controlled technical data;
- › EAR-controlled non-public technology or software;
- › Export-controlled drawings or technical data;
- › Government-restricted information;
- › Third-party confidential information;
- › Proprietary technical data;
- › Trade secrets;
- › Sensitive authentication credentials; or
- › Other information requiring specialized transmission or access controls.

If you need to provide such information to NPC, contact NPC first to establish an appropriate transmission method.

3. HOW WE USE INFORMATION

NPC may use information to:

Information You Provide

Information you voluntarily provide may include:

- › Operate, maintain, secure, and improve the Website; respond to inquiries;
- › Provide requested product or company information;
- › Evaluate requests for quotations;
- › Communicate with customers, prospective customers, suppliers, partners, and other business contacts;
- › Evaluate potential business relationships;
- › Understand Website usage and performance;
- › Improve our products, services, Website, and communications;
- › Protect NPC systems, personnel, customers, and information;
- › Prevent fraud, unauthorized access, or misuse;
- › Conduct export-control, sanctions, security, customer, end-user, or end-use screening where appropriate;
- › Comply with contractual requirements;
- › Comply with applicable laws, regulations, legal processes, and governmental requests;
- › Establish, exercise, or defend legal claims; and
- › Conduct legitimate business activities consistent with the context in which information was provided.

4. EXPORT-CONTROL AND COMPLIANCE INFORMATION

For certain transactions or requests, NPC may need to obtain information necessary to evaluate compliance with U.S. export-control, sanctions, contracting, or security requirements.

Such information may include:

- › Citizenship or nationality where legally appropriate and necessary;
- › Country of residence or location;
- › Company affiliation;
- › End-user information;

- › Intended end use;
- › Destination;
- › Government or military affiliation;
- › Transaction parties; and
- › Other information reasonably necessary for export-control or sanctions compliance.

NPC may use this information to determine whether information, products, services, software, technology, or technical data may lawfully be provided.

5. COOKIES AND SIMILAR TECHNOLOGIES

The Website may use cookies and similar technologies to operate the Website, remember preferences, maintain security, measure Website traffic, and understand Website usage.

Cookies may include:

- › **Essential Cookies** : necessary for Website functionality and security.
- › **Analytics Cookies** : used to understand Website traffic and visitor interactions.
- › **Preference Cookies** : used to remember selections or settings.
- › **Marketing Cookies** : if implemented, used to measure marketing effectiveness or support relevant communications.

Where required by applicable law, NPC will obtain consent before using non-essential cookies or similar technologies.

You may also control certain cookies through your browser settings.

6. ANALYTICS AND THIRD-PARTY WEBSITE SERVICES

NPC may use third-party services to host, secure, operate, analyze, or improve the Website.

These providers may process information on NPC's behalf in accordance with applicable agreements and their respective privacy practices.

7. HOW WE DISCLOSE INFORMATION

NPC may disclose personal information to:

- › Website hosting and technology providers;
- › Information-technology and cybersecurity providers;
- › Analytics providers;
- › Customer-relationship-management providers;
- › Professional advisers, including attorneys, accountants, auditors, and consultants;
- › Suppliers or business partners when reasonably necessary and appropriate;
- › Governmental or regulatory authorities when required by law;
- › Law-enforcement authorities when legally required or reasonably necessary to protect rights or security; and
- › A purchaser, successor, lender, investor, or other relevant party in connection with a merger, acquisition, financing, restructuring, or sale of all or part of NPC's business or assets.

NPC expects service providers processing information on its behalf to use information only as necessary to provide their services or as otherwise permitted by applicable law and contractual arrangements.

8. SALE AND TARGETED ADVERTISING

NPC does not sell personal information for monetary consideration.

NPC does not currently use personal information obtained through the Website for cross-context behavioral or targeted advertising.

If NPC's practices change in a manner that constitutes a "sale," "sharing," or use for targeted advertising under applicable law, NPC will update this Policy and provide applicable privacy controls as required.

9. BIOMETRIC INFORMATION

NPC does not intend to collect biometric identifiers or biometric information through its general public Website.

No facial recognition, voiceprint, fingerprint, retina/iris, or similar biometric technology is used by the Website.

If NPC later implements technology that collects or processes biometric information, NPC will establish appropriate notices, policies, consents, retention practices, and other procedures as required by applicable law.

10. DATA RETENTION

NPC retains personal information for periods reasonably necessary for the purposes for which it was collected, including to:

- › Respond to inquiries;
- › Provide products or services;
- › Maintain customer and business records;
- › Evaluate and document export-control or regulatory compliance;
- › Comply with contractual requirements;
- › Comply with legal and recordkeeping obligations;
- › Maintain security and audit records;
- › Resolve disputes; and
- › Establish, exercise, or defend legal claims.

Retention periods vary based upon the nature of the information, its purpose, applicable contracts, regulatory requirements, security considerations, and legal obligations.

When information is no longer reasonably required, NPC may delete, anonymize, or securely dispose of it in accordance with applicable policies and requirements.

11. INFORMATION SECURITY

NPC uses reasonable administrative, technical, and physical safeguards designed to protect personal information against unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration, loss, misuse, or destruction.

However, no Internet transmission, information system, or electronic-storage method can be guaranteed to be completely secure.

For this reason, users should not transmit classified, CUI, export-controlled technical data, trade secrets, or other highly sensitive information using the general Website unless NPC has expressly authorized the transmission method.

12. YOUR PRIVACY RIGHTS

Depending upon where you reside and the law applicable to NPC's processing of your personal information, you may have certain privacy rights.

These may include rights to:

- › Confirm whether NPC processes personal information concerning you;
- › Access certain personal information;
- › Correct inaccurate personal information;
- › Request deletion of certain personal information;
- › Obtain certain information in a portable format;
- › Obtain information regarding certain disclosures;
- › Opt out of certain sales or sharing of personal information;
- › Opt out of certain targeted advertising;
- › Opt out of certain profiling activities; and
- › Appeal certain decisions concerning privacy requests.

These rights are subject to applicable legal requirements, exceptions, exemptions, and verification requirements.

NPC will not unlawfully discriminate against an individual for exercising applicable privacy rights.

14. APPEALS

If applicable law gives you the right to appeal NPC's decision regarding a privacy request, you may submit an appeal using the contact information above.

NPC will review and respond as required by applicable law.

15. CHILDREN'S PRIVACY

The Website is intended for business, governmental, engineering, procurement, and professional audiences and is not directed to children.

NPC does not knowingly use the Website to collect personal information from children in violation of applicable law.

If NPC learns that personal information has been collected from a child in violation of applicable law, NPC will take appropriate steps to address or delete the information.

16. INTERNATIONAL VISITORS

NPC is based in the United States.

If you access the Website from outside the United States, information you provide may be transferred to, processed, and stored in the United States or other jurisdictions in which NPC or its service providers operate.

Where applicable, NPC will address international data-transfer requirements in accordance with applicable law.

17. THIRD-PARTY WEBSITES

The Website may contain links to websites operated by customers, suppliers, partners, governmental agencies, social-media providers, or other third parties.

NPC is not responsible for the privacy, security, content, or data practices of third-party websites.

Users should review the privacy policies of third-party websites they visit.

18. EMAIL COMMUNICATIONS

If you elect to receive marketing or informational email communications from NPC, you may unsubscribe using instructions contained in the communication or by contacting NPC.

NPC may continue to send transactional, operational, security, contractual, regulatory, or other non-marketing communications when appropriate.

19. PRIVACY PREFERENCE SIGNALS

Certain browsers or devices may transmit privacy preference signals.

Where applicable law requires NPC to recognize a particular opt-out preference signal and the signal applies to NPC's data-processing activities, NPC will process the signal as required by applicable law.

20. CHANGES TO THIS PRIVACY POLICY

NPC may update this Privacy Policy periodically to reflect changes in our Website, technologies, service providers, business practices, legal requirements, or privacy practices.

The date at the beginning of this Policy identifies the most recent revision.

NPC will provide additional notice of material changes where required by applicable law.
